MICHAEL BLOOMBERG (D-NY), a 2020 presidential candidate, has released key proposal and goals to address the affordable housing crisis.

MICHAEL BLOOMBERG'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING PLAN:

- Allocates \$10 billion in federal funds to remove obstacles to the construction of affordable housing units.
- Allocates \$10 billion to invest in a Housing Fairness Commission.
- Increases federal spending programs like Public Housing Capital Fund, the HOME program and Community Development Block Grants.
- Expands the Low Income Tax Credit to increase construction in low-income areas.
- Expands Fair Housing Act protections to include family status, veteran status, sexual orientation and source of funds.
- Increases funding for housing vouchers and accessibility for greater opportunities to relocate.
- Encourages cities to implement effective homelessness prevention programs.
