GOVERNOR STEVE BULLOCK (D-MT), a 2020 presidential candidate, has released key proposals and goals to address the affordable housing crisis.

GOVERNOR STEVE BULLOCK'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROPOSAL INCLUDES:

- Establishes a federal renters tax credit.
- Increases funding for the national Housing Trust Fund to support better maintenance of existing public housing and building new units.
- Lifts the moratorium on building new public housing.
- Funds more Project-Based Rental Assistance projects to expand housing options.
- Directs HUD to increase its focus on affordable housing in underserved neighborhoods, including those with large communities of color.
- Increase funding under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act to help with housing for seniors, people with disabilities, families with children, Native Americans, and veterans.
